

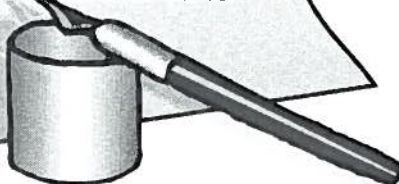

SUDAN EXCEEDS "I AM R U MEMBERSHIP INITIATIVE GOAL"

A new initiative was established at the 2017 Shriners International Imperial Session (annual meeting) in Orlando, Florida last July. Each temple was tasked to increase their membership whereby Sudan's number was set at 118 to run from July 2017 to July 2018. The results of this initiative, for all temples will be announced at the upcoming imperial session July 8-13, 2018.

Sudan membership as a whole put this as their first priority and it paid off. We had 58 new nobles from 2017 and 45 new nobles from our 2018 Winter Ceremonial giving us a 103 of the 118 needed. We then exceeded the required number with 38 new nobles at the Spring Ceremonial, May 4-5 at Atlantic Beach.

Illustrious Sir Teeny Jones set his goal for new nobles for the year at 150 and there is a real strong possibility that we can reach that goal. Let's get out and work for the September 8th, One-Day Ceremonial and finish out the Potentate's year with big numbers at the Fall Ceremonial in Wilson.
